Please find below some important information regarding your son/daughter's trip to Lightwater Valley

Prior to the trip, please make sure that they have all the relevant information below from their Group Tutor and that they have gone through all the details listed:

- That your son/daughter has given their mobile telephone number to their tutor
- They know what number bus they are on and then they can plan who to sit with,
- Have organised to get to the academy on time 8.30am and have arranged to get home at approx 5.30pm
- Have listened carefully to Tutors when they go through the trip risk assessment
- Organise who they are going to spend their time with when they go around the park. Should be with at least 2 other people.

On the day:

You will need to be at the academy in good time. The coaches will leave promptly at 8.45am – so don't be late – we won't be able to wait. If you are unable to come to school on the day, for example if you are ill, please telephone the academy to let us know.

Don't forget your mobile phone, packed lunch and any spending money you wish to take. (Please do not take large amounts in case it gets lost). You do not need to wear school uniform but you must dress sensibly and appropriately. Footwear is very important. Avoid fashion shoes and flip flops. Make sure you are prepared for the weather: rain – waterproof coats will be needed as we will be outside all day. If it is sunny, make sure you have a hat and sun cream.

When you are on the coach:

Put your seatbelt on. Your teacher will take a register and will allocate you to a member of staff. They will remind you of the risk assessment and the need for exemplary behaviour. At the park you will be representing our academy and excellent behaviour is expected at all times. You will be given an ID card which will say which academy you are from and a mobile number which you can use at any time to contact a member of staff from the academy. Please do this if you are worried about anything at all. Please let your teachers know if you have any questions or feel unwell on the coach.

When you arrive at the park:

Your teacher will escort you off the coach and take you to the meeting point. They will check once again that you are all ok, show you where members of staff will be all day, check you have the ID card and then you can go off into the park and have a great time.

At the park:

Enjoy yourselves. Be sensible and take care on the rides, stay with your group of friends, do not go off on your own at any time and behave appropriately. Staff at the park will make you aware if there are any height restrictions on rides.



All adults in school have a responsibility to safeguard and promote the welfare of children.

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Keep an eye on the time – **you will need to be back at your meeting point NO LATER THAN 3.00pm**

Prior to departure:

At 3.00pm your teachers will meet you at the designated meeting point so DO NOT BE LATE. They will register you prior to leaving the park. When everyone is present you will return to the coach where you will be registered once more before departure at 3.30pm

Back at the academy:

The coach is due to arrive back at the academy at approx. 5.30pm. Make sure you leave the coach clean and tidy. Please ask your parents/carers to park in the parking spaces so as not to block the bus turning circle. If we are going to be late your teacher will inform you in good time so that you can let your parents/carers know. When we are back at the academy please be careful travelling home.

If you are expecting a lift home and someone is delayed, a member of staff will wait with you until they arrive. **Do not try and make your own way home.**
