### Examination performance in 2024

#### GCSE Results 2024

##### Overall

65% of students gained a 4+ (standard pass) in English and Mathematics combined. 50% gained a grade 5+ or above in English and Mathematics combined.

61% of the cohort were entered for the English Baccalaureate/EBacc. 36% of this cohort achieved a band 4+ in this suit of qualifications. 22% of this cohort achieved a grade 5+. The Government refers to this as a 'strong' pass. The English Baccalaureate is achieved by students who grade 4+ in English, Maths, Science, a humanity and MFL.

Ebacc Average points score 2024 = APS 3.92.

##### Progress 8 Score

Progress 8 score shows how much progress students at Aston Academy made across 8 qualifications between end of key stage 2 and the end of key stage 4.

##### Value added Progress 8 score: -0.29

Measures the progress pupils make over a period of time. Value-added takes into account how much progress a child has made since their starting point (end of KS2), compared to the progress they have made relative to similar pupils.

Attainment 8 score is 4.4. This means the average grade Aston Academy students achieve in each subject is a grade 4 or above. This is in line with national average of 4.5. Attainment 8 is calculated by adding together students' highest scores across eight government approved school subjects.

##### GCSE English Language and Literature.

- English Language - 72% of all students gained a grade 4+ in English, 58% of all students gained a grade 5+ and 17% of all students gained a 7+ grade.
- English Literature - 68% of all students gained a grade 4+ in English, 56% of all students gained a grade 5+ and 11% of all students gained a 7+ grade.

##### GCSE Mathematics

- 72% of all students gained a grade 4+ in Maths
- 57% of students gained a grade 5+ and 20% gained a 7+ in Maths

##### Post 11 Destination measures

At Aston Academy we are committed to ensuring that students leave with the necessary skills and qualifications to access Post 16 education or training. **2023** data shows that 260 of the 262 (99.3%) students who progressed from Y11 at Aston Academy went into full time education or training. In **2024** 292/295 (99%) students from Y11 at Aston Academy went into full time education or training.

##### Post 16 results 2023

We are very pleased with the outcomes for students who completed their Y13 studies and wish them all the best of luck as they move onto further education and employment.

##### A Level Overview

- Average grade C+
